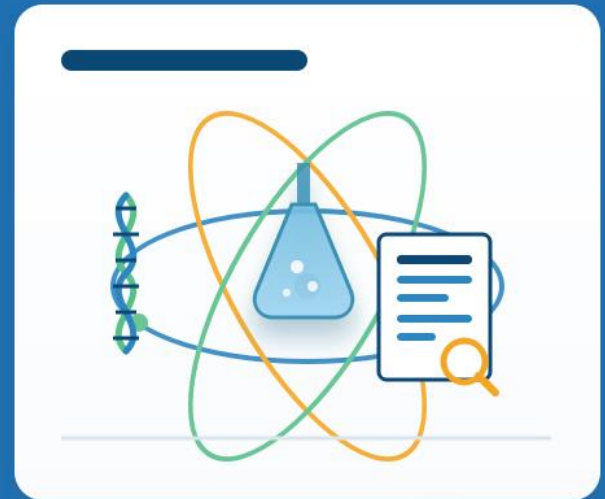

### **II. Proposal Format**

Scientific Research Paper are written according to the theme. Participants can choose one of the sub-themes and scope of limitations provided. The scientific research paper format bellow with the specification as follows:

1. Research papers must be typed on A4 paper with margins set to 4 cm (left) and 3 cm (right, top, and bottom), in Times New Roman font with 1.5 line spacing, except for the summary, which should be single-spaced.
2. Papers should be between 8,000 and 10,000 words, excluding cover pages, approval pages, and appendices.

### **III. Eligibility Requirements**

The participants of this competition are college students proven by a valid College Student ID / Identity Card.

### **IV. Competition Rules**

1. Participants must be current students in Associate's Degree and Bachelor's Degree,.
2. Submissions must be written in English.

3. The competition is open to both individual participants and teams. Teams may consist of a Team Leader and up to three additional members (four members total).
4. Each university may submit entries in multiple competition categories.
5. The submission must be an original work and must not have been previously submitted to any other competition or published elsewhere.
6. The submission should be written on A4 paper and submitted in PDF format.
7. Participants are required to cite external sources (literature) following APA Style guidelines.
8. The submitted work should be named in the following format: "Name of Team Leader\_Country\_Title" and submitted through the registration link provided in the event flyer.
9. Participants will be disqualified if proven to have committed plagiarism.
10. Registration fee is FREE.

## **V. Assessment Criteria**

The details of the Assessment Criteria are as follows:

1. Desk Evaluation Stage
  - a) Relevance to the theme and selected sub-theme (10%)
  - b) Originality and quality of youth-led innovation (15%)
  - c) Research methodology, evidence, and research ethics (15%)
  - d) Quality of analysis, discussion, and conclusions (10%)
  - e) Inclusiveness, feasibility, sustainability, and potential impact (10%)
2. Presentation Stage
  - a) Clarity and organization of presentation (10%)
  - b) Mastery of the research paper (10%)
  - c) Ability to answer questions (10%)
  - d) Visual communication and time management (5%)
  - e) Teamwork and equitable participation (5%)

The top 6 scientific research paper will be selected in Desk Evaluation stage. The selected paper will take part in Presentation stage held online via zoom meeting. The final assessment to determine the winner is carried out by including all the assessment stages with the following criteria:

1. Desk Evaluation (40%)
2. Presentation Stage (60%)

The decision of the jury is final and undisputed.
